

- Representatives of the Centres and the FAO constitute its Steering Committee - the Inter-Centre Working Group on Genetic Resources (ICWG-GR)
- Bioversity acted as convening centre and Programme Leader


### The Treaty was adopted by the FAO Conference on 3 November 2001








### **Building a multilateral system for PGR:**






### Agreements between the GB of the Treaty and the 11 CGIAR collections of PGR

- Settled the status of these international collections as being held "in trust" for the world community and
- Under the policy guidance of the Governing Body of the IT
- Represent half of the genetic resources in the multilateral system
- Represent over 90% of the genetic resources exchanged with SMTA


