Pre-OA Data Sharing

CGIAR Requirements on data sharing?

- CGIAR Open Access Policy
 - *Peer reviewed articles (Art 4.2.1)*
 - no later than 6 months
 - *Data and databases (Art 4.2.4)*
 - within 12 months of completion of data collection; or appropriate project milestone; or within 6 months of publication of information product underpinned by data
- *Silent as to pre-OA data sharing?*

Pre-OA Data Sharing

Barriers to pre-publication data sharing?

- Ambiguity re OA requirements (*Art 4.2.4*)
 - within 12 months of completion of data collection; or
 - appropriate project milestone; or
 - within 6 months of publication of information product underpinned by data
 - What does this mean in practice (e.g. one-off versus long term trials? Deliverables?)
- Responsible Open Access and data sharing?
 - Human subjects and privacy/ethical considerations Native traits and landraces
 - Traditional knowledge
 - Confidentiality and temporary restrictions

Pre-OA Data Sharing

Barriers to pre-publication data sharing?

- Legitimate expectations
 - attribution
 - Purpose/scope of use
 - rights concerning publication and transfer
 - Data versus findings derived from data
 - Security costs
- Supportive environment?
 - Your experiences?
